### William Shawcross

William Shawcross became a writer after leaving University College, Oxford in 1968. He was in Czechoslovakia during the Soviet occupation and this inspired his first book, a biography of Alexander Dubcek, published in 1970. Since then he has written and travelled widely. In 1995 he wrote the BBC Television series *Monarchy* and in 2002, to tie-in with the Queen's Golden Jubilee, he wrote and presented a landmark television series *Queen and Country* which offered an intimate portrait of the Queen and the changing face of Britain and the monarchy. He lives in London and Cornwall and is described as 'the foremost journalist of his generation'. His official biography of Queen Elizabeth, the Queen Mother, was published in 2009.

### Queen Elizabeth's Foundation for Disabled People

QEF is a registered national charity which provides solutions to the needs of people with complex disabilities. The charity enables and supports disabled people to increase independence and improve life skills. QEF provides four specialist services - Neuro Rehabilitation services, Independent Living services, Mobility services and Vocational services.

The Independent Living service works with disabled young people helping to develop the skills they need to enable them to move on to a lifestyle and location of their choice. Most clients come from home or school where they have had little opportunity to develop their life skills. They learn to take an increased level of responsibility in many areas such as money management, shopping, planning a social life and arranging and directing any help that they need. In a small group home environment or self-contained independent flats, clients may put into practice all that they have learnt before moving into a home of their own.
