**Our Construction Skills Alliance (Cskills) programme for Painting & Decorating is customised to meet individual ability and relevant employment opportunities. The programme is centred on the employability skills required to enable candidates to enter and succeed in the workplace.**

The following have been identified as most appropriate to reflect the needs of employers within the painting and decorating industry:

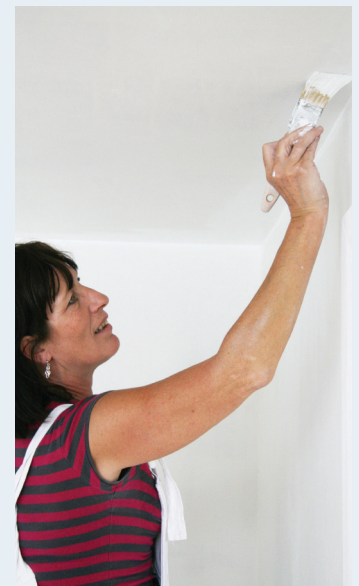
### Health & Safety

- Conforming to general safety in the workplace
- Conforming to efficient working practices in the workplace
- Moving and handling resources in the workplace
- Confirming work activities and resources for an occupational work area

### Painting & Decorating

- Applying paint systems by brush and roller
- Hanging standard paper wall coverings
- Preparing background surfaces for tiling or painting/decorating

Real work activities and interaction with customers and colleagues provide plenty of opportunities for improving skills and gaining confidence. Candidates are also able to work towards the CSCS (Construction Skills Certificate Scheme).
