Terms and Conditions

These terms and conditions are to ensure that you fully understand the risks associated with taking part in the Leatherhead Bikeathon 2011 (henceforth referred to as the 'Event').

They are designed for your safety and the safety of other participants. Please read carefully to avoid problems later.

1. The Event is to raise funds exclusively for QEF

By registering for this Event, you are committing to raising £20 in sponsorship for QEF in addition to your entry fee, which is non-refundable. The money raised is to be donated exclusively to QEF and no other charity.

2. Bicycles only

This is a bicycle only Event. Tandems are acceptable but motorised scooters or any other type of transport will not be accepted.

3. Safety

This Event involves cycling on roads amongst traffic. It is a potentially dangerous activity and whilst we will take reasonable care in making this a safe Event, you are agreeing to take part at your own risk by registering. You must ensure that your bike is roadworthy and that you understand the rules of the Highway Code and we require that you wear a correctly fitting bike helmet. You are also agreeing to follow the instructions of the marshals and officials at the Event.

4. Liability/insurance

QEF, managers or promoters of this Event cannot accept liability for injury, loss or damage caused or sustained as a result of taking part in this Event, howsoever arising, nor can they accept responsibility for any injury sustained or property damaged in the course of this Event in the absence of breach of statutory duty on their parts. The organisers, promoters and managers cannot accept any liability for any changes made to the Event for safety reasons, or as otherwise planned through circumstances beyond their control. You are strongly advised to comply with our safety guidelines and to obtain personal accident insurance cover as well as adequate material loss/damage insurance cover in respect of your bicycle and personal property and any loss or injury you may cause to a third party.

5. Health and Fitness

This is a cycling Event and therefore riders must be physically fit and in good health. If you are in any doubt that you should be taking part in this Event, you must seek advice from your doctor before participating. You must be physically fit to take part and we therefore recommend you train for this Event.

6. Photographic consent

By taking part, all participants confirm that they are happy for their names and any footage or photographs taken during their participation in the Event to be used to publicise the Event and QEF generally including use on posters, leaflets, websites and in the media.

7. Participation of Minors

Participants under the age of 16 must be accompanied by an adult. Participants under the age of 18 must have parental consent to take part in the Event.
